

THE CHARITABLE DEDUCTION IN ARIZONA

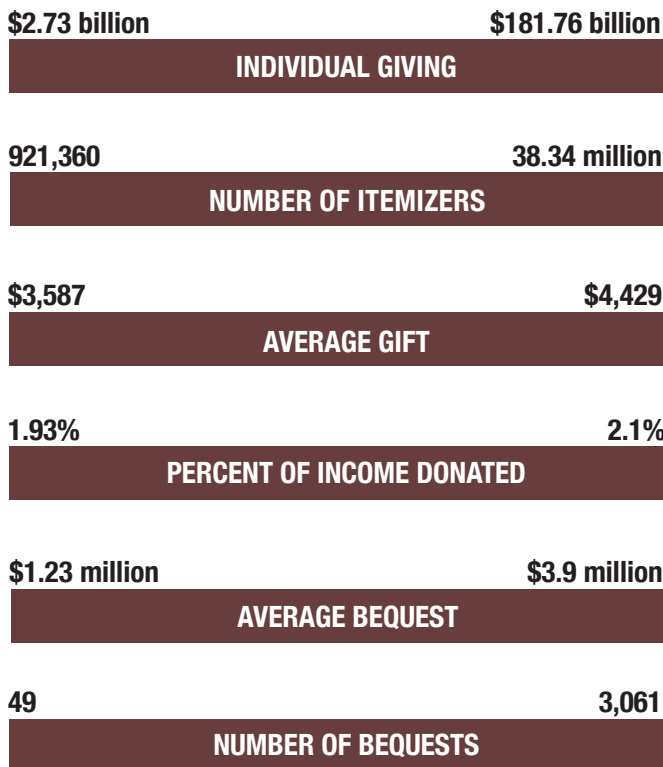
Individual Arizona residents donated almost \$2.8 billion to charities in 2010 either through bequests after death (\$60 million) or while alive. These Arizona contributions are nearly 1.5% of the \$181.76 billion Americans gave to their charitable causes.
