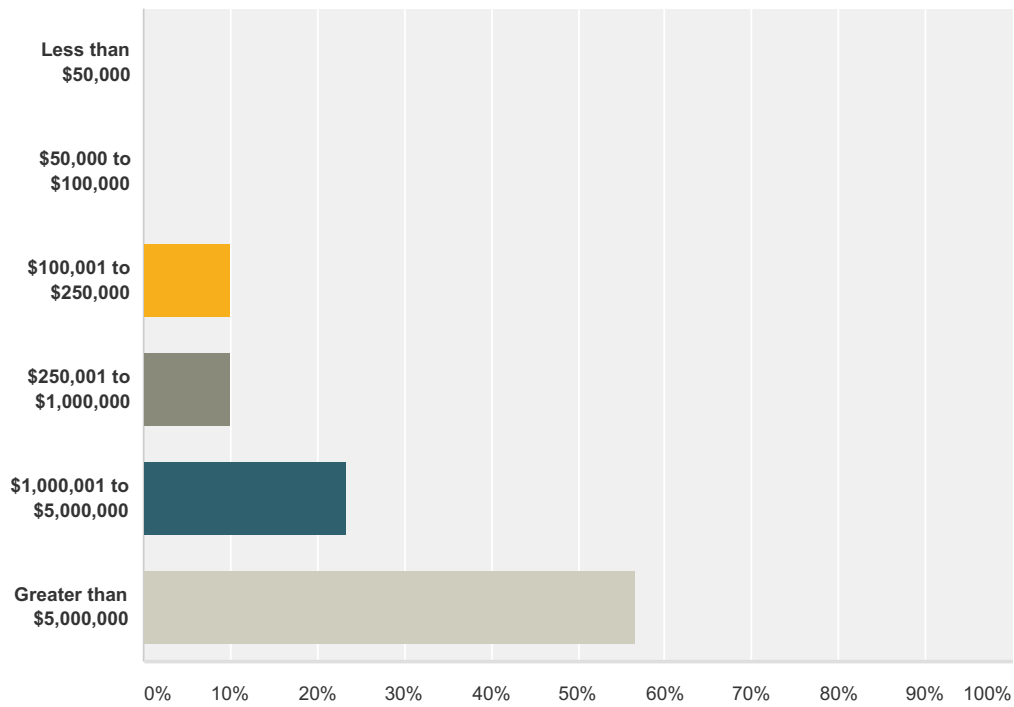

Q4 Grants budget for most recently completed fiscal year (Select One)

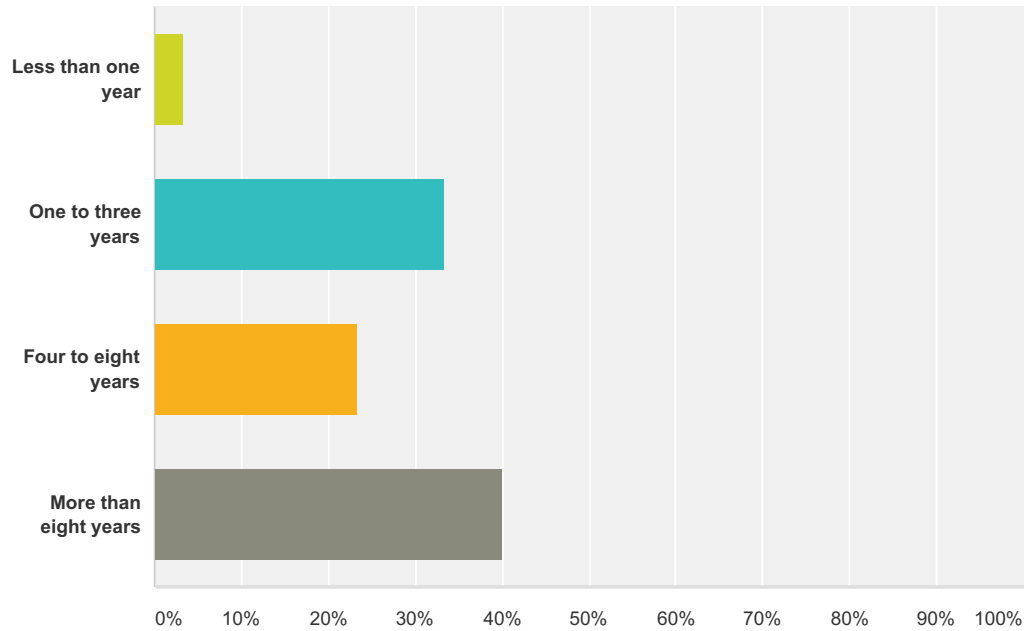

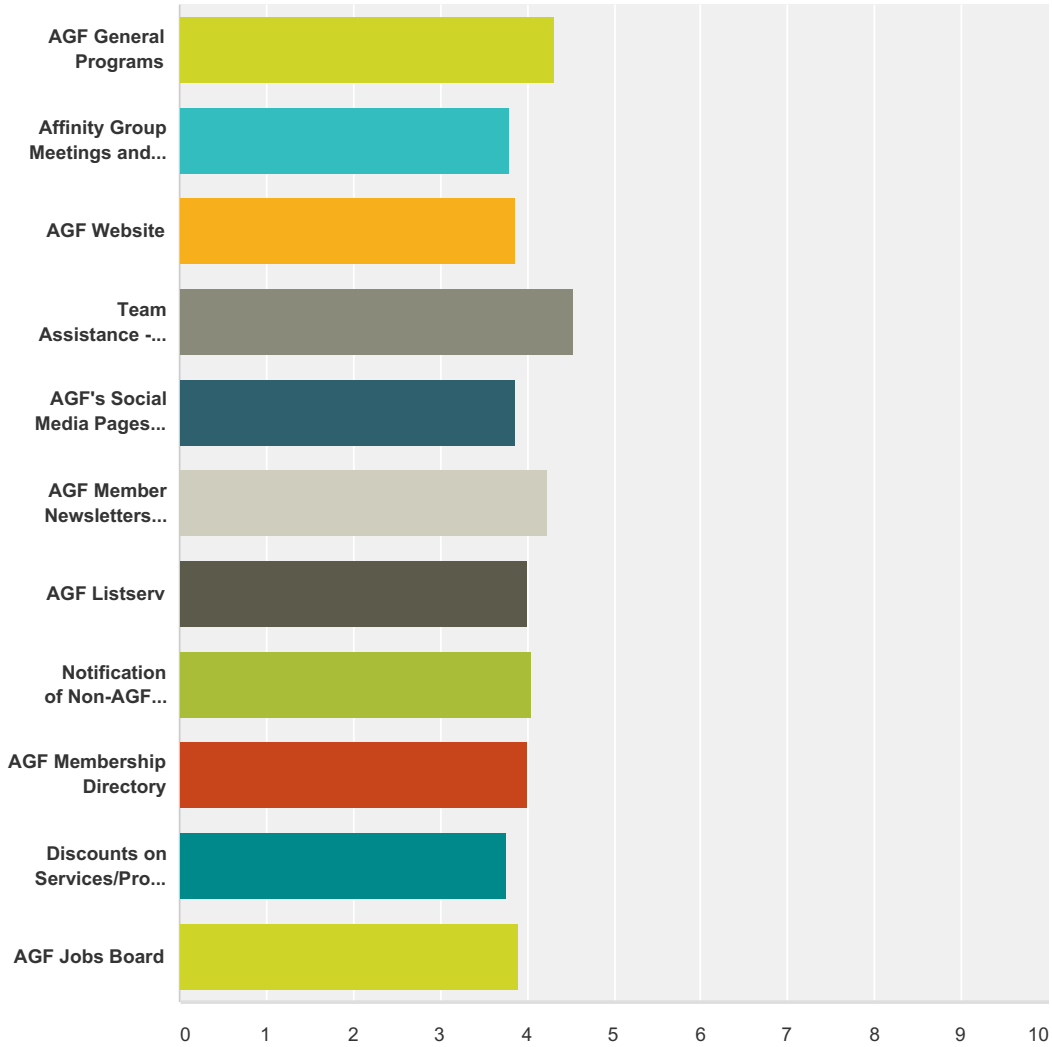

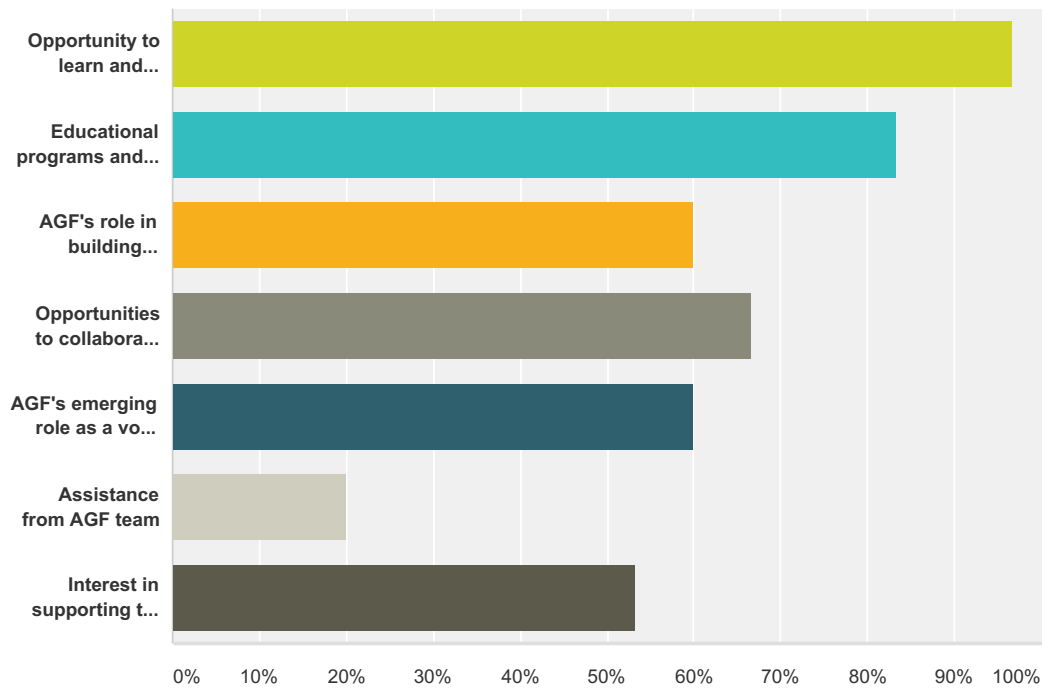

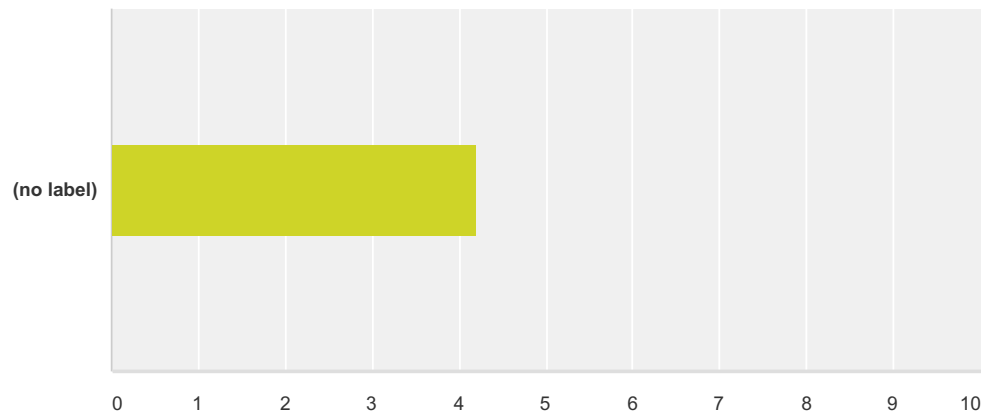

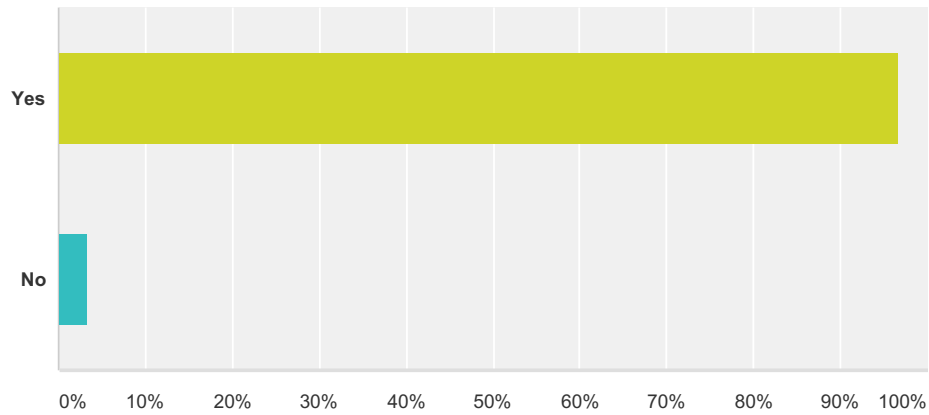
